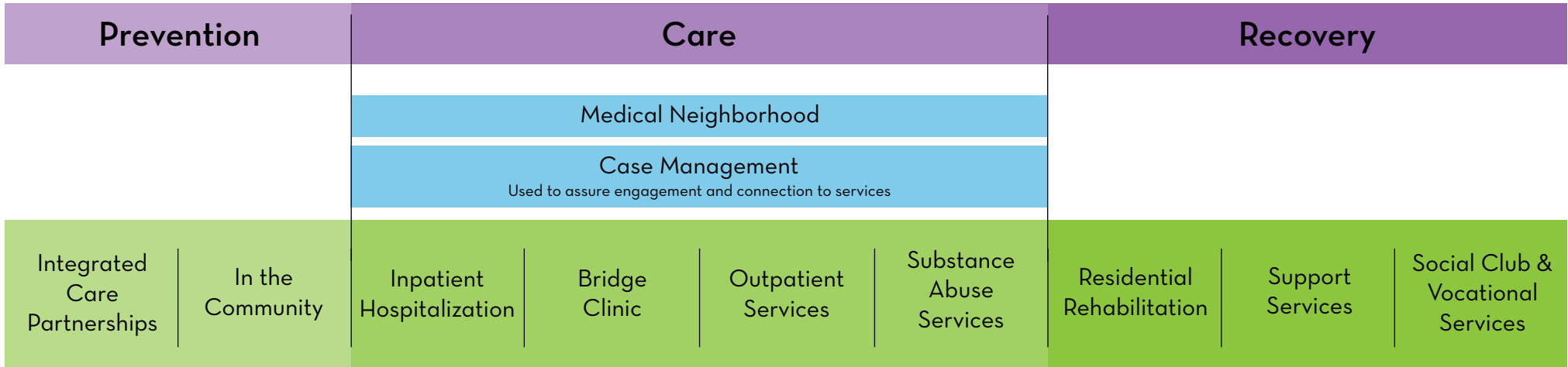

West Springs Hospital: Two 16 bed units serving both adolescents and adults. For those who need hospital level of care due to being gravely disabled or an imminent danger to themselves or others. Meeting 27-65 (involuntary hold) criteria

Bridge between hospital and outpatient care. Psychiatry, Case Management & Peer Support serve as “bridges” for those leaving inpatient services to assure engagement & connection to outpatient services

- Foundations for life-long sobriety are established through SA-specific Evidence-Based Practices
- Intensive & Extended Outpatient therapy Programs (IOP & EOP) allow patients the opportunity to live at home and work in the community while attending treatment

The Women’s Recovery Center: A 90-day intensive drug & alcohol rehabilitation program and the only one in the state that is for women-only and allows client’s young children to stay with them during treatment

- Peer Services provide opportunity for consumers who have achieved significant recovery to assist others in their recovery journeys. Peer specialists model recovery, teach skills and support those experiencing mental health challenges.
- Family Services: Education, understanding, encouragement. Support groups are available for children, adolescents and/or adult family members of West Springs Hospital patients during hospitalization or on-going.

- The Oasis Clubhouse** is a place for recovery, empowerment, fun and friendship, a place to hang out, receive support & reassurance and engage in meaningful work. Membership is free and open to anyone with mental health issues.
- Supported Employment Service assists people with mental illness in finding meaningful competitive jobs in the community
